REGULATION 2016

Metropolis, the international competition for short films on labour and social emergencies, is organized by StatutodeiLavoratori.it.

The first edition of Metropolis will be held in the city of Matera, from 13 to 16 July 2016.

Places and times will be communicated accurately and sufficiently in advance on

Registration is free. Works shot in any format and technique lasting up to 15 minutes, in Italian or any other language with subtitles in Italian or English, can participate.

The production of the shorts must be no earlier than 1 January 2015.

The short films will be accepted only in DVD format. On the cover there must be clearly indicated by the title, original format and duration. The DVD containing the short film must be sent together with the registration form, completed in all its parts and with lime autographed signature, in a sealed envelope by 31 May 2016 (postmark date) to the following address:

In the envelope containing the DVD the applicant has to send the following documents:

- 1) a bio-filmography of the author
- 2) a synopsis of the short film of maximum 10 lines
- 3) a signed declaration in which declares him/herself responsible for the content of the work presented and the copyrighted music broadcast, as an alternative to the original music, assures and also declares that the work does not contain any libelous, and authorizes the Association StatutodeiLavoratori.it to perform projections even outside the Metropolis event, notwithstanding the absence of any profit and for social promotion.

All the works will be preselected by a committee formed by the organizers. The 10 finalist short films will be selected by the Artistic Director, the Scientific Director and members of the association StatutodeiLavoratori.it.

The winners will be designated by the competition jury, made up of prominent professionals in the arts and sciences.

The prizes are:

- Best Short Film: € 1,000 (one thousand euros// 00) - funded by the Lucania Film Commission
- Special Jury Prize: € 500 (five hundred euros// 00)
- Special mention, with a plaque of recognition, for best screenplay, best director, best actor, best short of Basilicata, and best short of Puglia.

Entries will not be returned.

The organization is not responsible for damage or loss of submitted works.

On the final evening only the winners who will be presented physically to collect the prize, in person or by proxy, will be awarded.
